

## Arrangements for Caravan Sales

Social Distancing is extremely important. Currently we are at two metres although it's likely that this will be reduced. Please be aware of the importance of this and remind others constantly where required. Frequent hand washing/sanitizing essential.

Viewing of caravans for sale to be by appointment only. There must be a min. of one hour between visits to allow the caravan to be ventilated - open the windows where possible. Internal doors of caravans to be left open to avoid handling - where possible.

Customers arriving for viewing (by appointment) to be asked to use hand sanitizer and also not to touch surfaces within the caravan where possible.

Upon meeting a customer, meet outdoors where possible. Do not travel in the customers vehicle en route to the caravan; do not enter the accommodation at the same time as the viewer. Wait outside.

The person who takes the customer to view the caravan is responsible for cleaning any touched surfaces after the viewing. ie door handles.

Caravan for sale keys to be sanitized after a customer has viewed a caravan by the person handling the viewing.

Individual customers can be taken to view the caravan by the warden providing they are comfortable in doing this and it is suggested that wardens wear a mask/shield when doing this. All touched surfaces of the buggy to be cleaned upon completion.
